CONNECTICUT ADOPTED MECHANICS

- I. Point to the floor with "one" finger to indicate the shooter's foot touching the "3" point line (i.e. 2 point field goal is being attempted). Trail should mirror the Lead if Trail's PCA vision can see the Lead pointing. However, Lead should never mirror the Trail.
- II. Team members are not allowed to congregate at the division line or on the school logo during introductions. Coaches and officials will direct players to the free throw line area in front of their respective benches.
- III. Captains-Head Coaches-Officials pre-game meeting should occur between 5 to 10 minutes prior to the start of the game. If the head coach refuses to attend the meeting, notify your Board Secretary or Assignment Commissioner, who will then notify the school's Athletic Director and the CIAC.
