Member Expectations & Financial Obligations Policy 2017-18

1. Guidelines for Member Financial Obligations

- Postmark will determine date received
- Late Payment Fee is \$50. Applies if check does not clear
- Returned check fee is \$25 which is added to Late Payment Fee if applicable
- Dues will not be considered paid until Late Payment Fee (and Returned Check fee, if applicable) has been paid
- Dues, Fees, and/or Fines are not refundable

A. Membership Dues

- Dues for 2018-19 season – \$125.00
- Submission Due Date is March 1, 2018
- Late Payment Fee - \$50

B. Game Assignment Fee

- 7% of total game assignment earnings
- Submission Due Date is March 22, 2018
- Late Payment Fee - \$50

C. Fines

1. Commissioner

- Missed game assignments – full game fee
- Game Turn Back due to Not Closing Date - \$15

2. Arbiter Late Rating – If submitted more than 5 days from game date

- 1 Late or Missed – No Fine
- 2 to 3 Late or Missed - \$25 Total
- 4 or more Late or Missed - \$50 Total

3. Missed Meeting(s)

- A fine of \$25 will be assessed for each meeting not attended beyond one missed meeting.

4. Submission Due Date for All Fines is 30 days from date of fine letter email.

- Late Payment Fee - \$50 for all payments 31 days and later.
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D. Penalty For Non-Compliance with A – Membership Dues & B – Game Assignment Fee

If not paid by April 5, 2018 – Eligible for Assignments January 15, 2019

If not paid by May 1, 2018 - No Assignments for entire season

E. Penalty For Non-Compliance with C – Fines

If not paid within 60 days of fine letter email, No Assignments for entire season

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2. Member Expectations

- Comply with the Code of Ethics and Conduct
- Fulfill meeting and member ratings requirements and attend refresher exam meetings
- Keep Arbiter and Secretary updated with correct e-mail, address, picture, unavailable dates/times, cell/home phone #s
- Confirm game assignments on Arbiter and with school and partner
- Arrive at game site in timely manner and appropriately dressed - business casual, no jeans.
- Notify Assignment Commissioner regarding coach/player ejections immediately and submit appropriate report.
- Wear correct uniform - Black pants, socks & shoes, black/white striped shirt w/IAABO emblem on left chest and American flag on back of shirt near collar, Bd. #6 jacket
- Varsity members arrive early to observe subvarsity officials and subvarsity officials remain to observe varsity officials.
- Report all Unsporting Technical Fouls on a coach or bench personnel to Assignment Commissioner within 24 hours via email. Applies to all levels.
- Submit Arbiter Rating on all partners in all games within 5 days. Does not apply to scrimmages.
